



NSW Shooting Championships

Open and Over 60s Divisions

Saturday 21 February 2026

The NSW Open and Over 60s (separate men's and women's competitions in each) Shooting Championships for 2026 will be held at:

Where - Newcastle Petanque Club

Address of play – Nesca Park, Cnr Brook St and Nesca Pde, Cooks Hill

Register – by going to mynetanque.com

Registrations – closes Thursday 19 February at 12mn. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entry Fee - \$10 per player and \$5 per junior – CASH ONLY

Competition Format – in accordance with the **NSWPL Competition Regulations 2026 and PFA Rules**, each shooter must perform a complete series of 20 throws: 1 throw each at 6M,7M,8M and 9M for 5 separate targets. In each division, after two qualifying rounds, the national qualifiers are announced, followed by semi-finals in each division consisting of 1 vs 4 and 2 vs 3 playing side-by-side with winners of each playing off in the NSW Championship final.

Start Times – PLEASE NOTE

For Over 60s - 9.30am sharp, check in by no later than 9.00am

For Open – 2pm sharp, check in by no later than 1.30pm

Prizemoney on Offer – \$25 1st prize for each division for men and women. Medal for junior winner.

As per the **NSWPL Competition Regulations 2026** players must score a minimum of 30 for men and 25 for women to win the State Title.

As per PFA directives, after the first two rounds, the highest scorers in each division, will be eligible to be the national champions for 2025, provided the minimum scores of 30 for men and 25 for women are met. Link below to FIPJP Shooting Rules
